Classification	Designated Bags	Examples	Notes
<div>も 燃やす 袋 ごみ</div> <div>Burnable waste</div>		<div>Food waste, leather shoes &amp; sneakers, leaves (small volume), disposable diapers (empty contents into the toilet), etc.</div>	<div>■Burnable items that can fit into the designated bag</div> <div>• Items that won't fit into the designated bag are <b>Large burnable waste</b>.</div> <div>• Drain food waste well.</div> <div>• To dispose of cooking oil, use paper to soak it up.</div>
<div>ぷ ら よ う き ほう そ う</div> <div>プラ容器包装</div> <div>Plastic containers and packaging</div>		<div>Labels, containers (shampoo, conditioner, softener), food nets, shopping bags, packing films, foam food containers, egg crates, etc.</div>	<div>■Plastic containers and packaging with a plastic mark</div> <div>• Clean well. Items that are hard to wash are <b>Burnable waste</b>.</div> <div>• Do not double plastic shopping bags.</div>
<div>そ の 他 プ ラ</div> <div>Other plastics</div>		<div>Buckets, plastic plates &amp; cups, plastic toys (non-battery-powered), plastic kerosene containers (empty contents), etc.</div>	<div>■Plastic items under 1 meter, excluding Plastic containers and packaging</div> <div>• Items 1 meter and over are <b>Large non-burnable waste</b>.</div> <div>• Items that won't fit into the designated bag must be labelled “Other plastics.”</div>
<div>ぺ っ と ぼ と る</div> <div>ペットボトル</div> <div>PET bottles</div>		<div>Remove the cap and the label. Rinse the inside and drain well. Dispose of the cap and the label as <b>Plastic containers and packaging</b>.</div>	<div>■Colorless and transparent bottles with a PET mark</div> <div>• Colored PET bottles are <b>Other plastics</b>.</div> <div>• Remove caps and labels, and dispose of them as <b>Plastic containers and packaging</b>.</div>
<div>び ん ・ か ん 類</div> <div>Bottles and cans</div>		<div>Remove the lid and rinse the inside.</div>	<div>■Glass containers, drinking glasses, and metallic containers (less than 4 liters)</div> <div>• Bottles and cans can go into one bag.</div> <div>• Always remove the lid. Metallic lids go into the same bag.</div> <div>• Bottles of cosmetics, ointments, and agricultural chemicals are <b>Landfill waste</b>.</div>
<div>き ん ぞ く る い</div> <div>金 属 類</div> <div>Metals</div>	<div>Use a separate bag for each category of recyclables しげん “資源ごみ”.</div>	<div>Kettles, aluminum foil, frying pans, metal cutlery, etc.</div> <div>Aerosol cans (use it up and punch a hole. Plastic caps are <b>Plastic containers and packaging</b>.)</div>	<div>■Items under 1 meter, made of iron, aluminum, or stainless steel, excluding Bottles and cans</div> <div>• Includes plastic composite products with undetachable metal parts.</div> <div>• Items 1 meter and over are <b>Large non-burnable waste</b>.</div> <div>• Items that won't fit into the designated bag must be labelled “Metals.”</div>
<div>こ が た か で ん ひ ん</div> <div>小型家電品</div> <div>Small electrical appliances</div>		<div>Gas stoves (remove batteries), electric carpets (put the remote on top), fan heaters, electric cords, etc.</div>	<div>■Electrical appliances with electric cords, and battery-powered items</div> <div>• Excludes personal computers and the “6 Electrical Appliances” (See <b>Waste not accepted</b>.). Remove batteries, and dispose of them as <b>Hazardous waste</b>.</div> <div>• Items that won't fit into the designated bag must be labelled “Small electrical appliances.”</div>
<div>う め た て</div> <div>埋 立 ご み</div> <div>Landfill waste</div>		<div>Glassware, ceramics, pots, rubber products (hoses, gloves, boots), ash (soak with water), etc.</div>	<div>■Items which are hard to recycle and under 1 meter</div> <div>• Items 1 meter and over are <b>Large non-burnable waste</b>.</div> <div>• Items that won't fit into the designated bag must be labelled “Landfill waste.”</div> <div>• Broken glass must be wrapped in paper and labelled “Glass.”</div>
