かねんけいしげん 可燃系資源 Flammable resources		(1) Newspapers, inserts (2) Magazines, books, paper cartons, scrap paper (3) Cardboard boxes (4) Clothing	■Resources such as used paper and cloth • Sort them into the four categories listed on the left. Bind them with string. • Items will be collected even on rainy days. Refrain from taking them out in heavy rain. • Curtains and winter clothes lined with cotton wool are Burnable waste.
大型不燃ごみ (属出制) Large non-burnable waste (notification required)		Steel desks, steel beds, bicycles, sofas, mattresses with springs, etc.	■Items 1 meter and over with parts that cannot be burned • 2 items per household per day • Contact the city at least 5 days before collection day. • Each item must be labelled with your name and address to show that you have contacted the city.
^{おおがたかねん} 大型可燃ごみ Large burnable waste		Wooden furniture (chests, chairs, desks, etc.) (Remove glass or metal parts. Must be under 1 meter.) Tatami (Contact the city at least 5 days before collection day.) Wood and boards (under 1 meter long and 20 centimeters in diameter) Kotatsu (Remove the electric heater and the plastic/metal edge of the table top.) Futons and blankets (Fold up and bind with string.)	■Burnable items that won't fit into the designated bag • Must be under 1 meter. Bind with string. • Tatami (maximum: 5 mats). Contact the city at least 5 days before collection day.
ゅうがい 有 害 ご み Hazardous waste	Use transparent or translucent bags.	Fluorescent lights (Incandescent light bulbs are Landfill waste.) Don't break them. If possible, put them in a protective box they came in. Separate fluorescent lights from other hazardous waste such as lighters, batteries and tapes. Lighters (including grill lighters) Use it up and empty contents. Batteries (manganese cells and alkaline cells only). Button cells, nickel-cadmium cells and mercury cells must be brought into appliance stores. Video tapes, cassette tapes (Plastic cases are Other plastics.)	 Items that are hard to process at the recycling center Place it in a clear plastic bag with contents visible. Separate fluorescent lights from other hazardous waste. Batteries (manganese cells and alkaline cells only) are also collected at the city hall and community centers.
収集しない ごみ Waste not accepted	6 Electrical Appliances	The "6 Electrical Appliances" (TVs, air conditioners, refrigerators, freezers, washing machines, and clothes dryers), personal computers, car parts, motorcycles, batteries, pianos, pharmaceuticals, fire extinguishers, gas cylinders, button cells, etc.	■ Ask a dealer or specialist for proper disposal. • The "6 Electrical Appliances" require a recycling fee. • Temporary large volume waste should be brought in by yourself or by a transport company with a city permit. • Business owners should properly dispose of waste generated by business activities.
